Children from Northernland Trust Spring holiday activity

In Quarter 2, YBF was busy actively supporting, representing and advocating for our members. We saw an increase in the number of 1-2-1 meetings, which offer valuable opportunities provide support and facilitate partnerships through community introductions. These efforts are crucial in building the capacity and resilience of the sector. Additional support was provided through the Member Network Meeting, Children Out of Sight of Services safeguarding event and Ofsted Paediatric First Aid training - See [Highlights This Quarter](#) for more details

This year we have awarded £75,707 to our members through Space2Grow. Notably, 52% of this funding was allocated to the Spring BACE programme, which offers holiday activities with food to children and young people on free school meals. As a result, 2,483 children and young people had access to various activities in the Spring - See [Member Delivery](#) for more details

Our ongoing fundraising activities continue to generate essential funds, elevate YBF's profile and strengthen our relationship with the local community and strategic partners. We received generous donations from BNY Mellon and Nisa this quarter.

Thanks to the volunteers at BNY Mellon, over 500 "Bags of Sunshine" will be available for the children and young people attending Summer BACE activities - See [Highlights This Quarter](#) for more details



Children Out of Sight of Services Safeguarding event

14 people attended the Children Out of Sight of Services event in June held at the RAF Museum.

The event was led by experts from BELS, NHS, Young Carers, and MASH. It was an opportunity to learn from top experts, connect with peers, and gain practical insights into ensuring all children receive the help they need when they need it.

Corporate Donations



£600 was donated to our Space2Grow and Young People's fund by our local Nisa's Make a Difference Locally charity



As part of BNY's 240th anniversary 60 volunteers assembled over 500 "Bags of Sunshine" for the children and young people participating in this Summer's BACE HAF programme.

Each bag, funded by a £6,000 donation from BNY, includes items like pens, squishy balls and water bottles.

BNY also contributed \$25 per volunteer hour, totalling \$1,750
