


Member Delivery

Data and feedback continues to highlight the value of our vital support to a broad range of members who directly serve vulnerable local children and young people. One measure of success that we at YBF are particularly proud of is facilitating collaborations and connections between smaller organisations and key, national funders. Without our support, these opportunities may not happen.

In Quarter 1 of 2024, YBF hosted a well-attended funding panel event, during which 3 national funders presented for and connected with our members. Thanks to these interactions, some of our members subsequently won much-needed funding to broaden and protect services for those most in need. This success is more remarkable given the challenging and uncertain economic climate.

One such success story is Strength and Learning Through Horses who have been awarded £500,000 over 5 years from The National Lottery Community Fund!
