Opening two warm spaces 6 days a week for families and individuals to access warmth, hot meals, drinks, fruit and to socialise

Creating a bank of 50 refurbished computers for local people, supporting more people in need, improving the quality of donations and providing meaningful training for people furthest away from the job market

Delivering a 49 week social inclusion football project for mixed gender aged groups between 12-18 years old

Delivering three specialist groups (Art, Social and Multimedia) for autistic adults every week


