Our team was hard at work supporting members through 1-2-1 meetings, hosting vibrant network meetings and providing valuable training sessions. The feedback from our members ([on page 7](#)) is a testament to the tremendous value these connections and meetings have provided, helping to strengthen relationships and build a stronger, more resilient community.

The winter HAF programme saw children enjoying various activities over the festive period. Our Space2Grow fund wrapped up the year with an impressive £423,580* distributed to grassroots organisation, making a real difference in the community.

Our annual Christmas campaign was a huge success raising over £27,000! This success wouldn't have been possible without the overwhelming generosity of our corporate partners and the local community. Thanks to their contributions, nearly 3,000 presents were distributed to disadvantaged children and young people, ensuring they could experience joy during the festive period. 





Member Network Meetings

In October, 45 people attended the network meeting, which focused on exploring ways to strengthen collaboration between the voluntary sector and schools to better support the needs of our children and young people.

The December network meeting brought together 40 attendees to explore the critical relationship between poverty and mental health in Barnet.

Member Training

In October, as part of the Barnet Together, 27 people attended the Writing For Impact training session. It focused on enhancing bids through the use of compelling case studies and effective writing techniques. The session provided valuable tips and best practices, helping both beginners and experienced participants refine their skills and increase their chances of success in securing funding.

15 people attended the learning disabilities & autism awareness training delivered by Barnet Mencap in November. The event offered valuable insights and practical strategies to support those working with children and adults with learning disabilities and autism.
