In a vibrant spring quarter, Young Barnet Foundation (YBF) continued its impactful work with the Voluntary Community Faith and Social Enterprise (VCFSE) Children and Young People's sector.

The number of 1-2-1s with members rose again this quarter, these 1-2-1s provide valuable opportunities to provide support and broker partnerships through community introductions, helping to build the capacity and resilience of the sector. Feedback from members on page 6 demonstrates the Member Development Team's efforts, planting seeds we hope will lead to fruitful partnerships (outcomes in future quarterly reports), and enhance the service delivery for children/young people/families across the borough.

Following a successful spring BACE in which 2,176 children/young people benefited, 24 Members have received funding and are geared up to deliver Summer BACE, the holiday activity with food sessions for CYP on free school meals.

Whilst there were no network meetings in Q2, due to a rearranged June meeting, there were a number of training sessions including a successful Charity Excellence Framework workshop, this ensures that organisations are equipped with robust processes to support their development, helping to grow internal and external confidence in their governance/back office. YBF and our members played an active role in assisting the Borough in the development of a new Mental Health Charter, supporting the dissemination of funding, assisting delivery or offering delivery advice on resident engagement, and crucially gathering feedback from young people and wider groups to inform the co-design. Volunteering opportunities were light on the ground but we are thankful that we have a reliable group willing to support our efforts.

The roll-out of the Upshot continues. A monitoring and evaluation tool, which is currently Free for the VCFSE Sector across Barnet, will help provide member groups with valuable data to support strategic decision-making for the local sector.

We have successfully hosted our first Charity Golf Day to build crucial partnerships within the community in order to raise vital funds for our Space2Grow Children and Young People's Fund, nearly £5,000 was raised. Roll on Quarter 3!

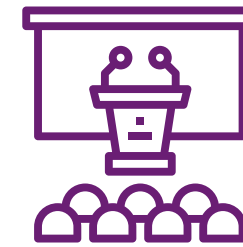

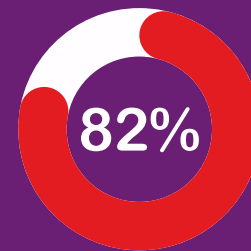

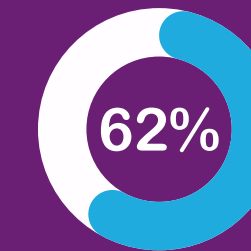
