WHAT DO WE DO?




Youth Realities runs a range of bespoke in-school and community based programmes that addresses teenage relationship abuse and other social issues that impact young people; supporting survivors with rebuilding themselves in a safe and inclusive environment.

Our in-school programmes are introductory workshops that raise awareness and provide young people with the knowledge and skills to make more informed and healthy choices around their relationships and behaviour.

Our community programmes include empowerment sessions for at-risk young women and increasing engagement in fitness through fun and inclusive dance classes.

Other work we do includes advocacy and delivering bespoke and holistic workshops that focus on self-care, building resilience, healing from trauma and interpersonal skills such as confidence and stress management.

ROLE DESCRIPTION



The duties and responsibilities of a Trustee include:

- To ensure that they are present at all meetings.
- To actively support in difficult decision making processes and have Youth Realities' best interest at heart, at all times.
- To contribute towards the organisation by being involved in discussions, establishing strategies, identifying targets and working towards improvements.
- To ensure they are informed and up to date in terms of the doings of the organisation.
- To advise on matters in an honest, impartial and sound way.
- (Treasurer) To support with making decisions about the use of company finances and managing money to ensure effective use of the funding received.
- To oversee, support and hold Management accountable.

This list is not exclusive and Trustee's are encouraged to announce on recruitment how they plan to best support Youth Realities and what they can be relied on to contribute towards.



COMMITMENT



- The term of a Trustee is 24 months, with a 6 month probational period. After which, Trustees may be re-elected to serve a 3 year term before their next election.
- Meetings are held quarterly (every three months).
- Meetings are scheduled with the Trustee's other commitments in mind; all Trustee's are expected to communicate in advance if they are unable to attend.
- Meetings are usually held in the evenings and location can be flexible if required by a majority of members.
- In addition to board meetings, other communication will be necessary. This can be through face to face meetings, phone calls or via email.
